- Attach the form in an email to NAIDOCnominations@niaa.gov.au and include any supporting evidence. Examples of supporting evidence include: testimonials, photos, resumes, news articles, portfolios, and websites to support your nomination.
- Ensure the selection criteria on page 3 of this form is addressed.
- There is no word count for your reasons for nominating.

- The individual's future goals and their likely impact

Please note Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander groups, businesses and organisations are able to be nominated for the Creative, Caring for Country and Culture, Education and Innovation Award Categories.

Please write a paragraph addressing the criteria above and explaining your reasons for nominating. If you are nominating for more than one award category, please ensure you address the multiple categories in your statement. You can provide additional information like testimonials, photos, resumes, news articles, portfolios, and websites to support your nomination. This can be included as attachments when emailing the nomination form.

Final selection may be subject to the provision of additional information.
